Free School Meals

Instant approval from the ECS web-service

Local Authority users of the Victoria Forms solution can use the Department for Education Eligibility Checking Service (ECS) to evaluate the eligibility of new applications without the need for claimants to provide evidence of qualifying benefits (the ECS checks against data held by HMRC, DWP and the Home Office). The ECS service has recently been expanded to check eligibility for Free School Meals, Funded Early Learning for Two Year Olds and Early Years Pupil Premium.

An analytical advancement to the service provided by the ECS to Local Authorities is to allow applicants to check their own eligibility via the self-service channel and therefore reduce administrative overheads. Working in collaboration with Waltham Forest Council, Victoria Forms have created a standardised eForm that allows applicants to see their eligibility and obtain a confirmation letter (print out or a PDF copy) in real time after submitting their eForm. In theory, this powerful dynamic allows children of the applicant to receive their meal entitlement within 24 hours of eligibility being confirmed.
